Tele-Counselling Week 4th to 8th May, 2020

As we know that due to the coronavirus pandemic the state governments across the country have temporarily shut down schools and colleges. As per the present situation there is an uncertainty when schools and colleges will reopen.

The Counselling Cell (TCC) of BHKM organised a tele-counselling week to assess the psychosociological impact of the COVID pandemic on the college students of BHKM. Due to the pandemic, TCC decided in an online meeting held on 30th April 2020 that share

their experiences, anxieties and worries which they were facing due to the lockdown. Dr. Runa Das Chaudhuri acted as the Convener of the Programme, Rejaul Molla as the Chief Advisor and Paromita Mondal as a member of the programme committee

8 students were contacted and were interviewed over phone by Dr. Das Chaudhuri during the week long programme from 4th to 8th May, 2020. The tele-conversations were recorded and the audio files were transcribed by her. This was a modest attempt to reach out to students during difficult times. The conversations indicated that college students' anxiety regarding the pandemic was associated with economic stressors. Coping up with online academic classes were found to be positively associated with the level of anxiety students faced during the lockdown.

Protest against racism

On May 25, 2020, George Floyd, a 46-year-old black man, was murdered in Minneapolis, Minnesota, United States, while being arrested on suspicion of using a counterfeit \$20 bill. During the arrest, Derek Chauvin, a white police officer with the Minneapolis Police Department, knelt on Floyd's neck for eight minutes and forty-six seconds after he was handcuffed and lying face down. Two other police officers, J. Alexander Kueng and Thomas Lane, assisted Chauvin in

restraining Floyd. A fourth police officer, Tou Thao, prevented bystanders from interfering. Floyd's

murder led to worldwide protests against police brutality, police racism, and lack of police accountability. The students of the Department of Sociology, BHKM prepared a poster to show solidarity to the cause of protesting against the gruesome killing of George Floyd.
