


Report of the Student Satisfaction Survey: 2023 – 2024

The Student Satisfaction Survey 2023 - 24 of BHKM was conducted in the months of November and December 2023. A total number of 100 students participated in the survey and the students were selected by the convenient method. The SSS was conducted by Dr. Jayanta Sarkar, Assistant Professor of Sanskrit, and the results of the survey followed by a vigorous discussion of all aspects was presented before the faculty members by the SSS Committee. The analysis indicated that there was the need to complete the syllabus of different disciplines on time. Further the students observed that there was lack of field visits and the use of ICT techniques in classroom teaching. These dimensions the report suggested required attention. In addition to this the discussion among the faculty also pointed out to the need for adopting at least one innovative teaching strategy to be adopted alongside the traditional method of classroom lecture. Also the Counselling, Guidance and Placement Cell of the college required to devise ways to train students in some job-related skills so that they would be better placed in the job market in future. The performance of students in assignments needed to be discussed more thoroughly with students. Hence the process of continuous internal evaluation (CIE) needs to be take up more forthrightly. The continuous internal evaluation (CIE) should be taken timely and discussion between the examinee and examiners should be followed. This process will facilitate redressal of weaknesses of students in studies which will be remedied in their upcoming examination.


Result of the Survey




Only 50% of the respondents say that at least 84% of the syllabus is covered revealing that syllabus completion is the need of the hour.




64% of the students perceived that teachers are able to communicate well indicating proper teaching learning environment.




85% of the students seem satisfied that their teachers teach well indicating proper academic potency of teachers.




A total of 88% of students mentioned that the teacher's approach to teaching was good revealing that standards is teaching are satisfactory.




A majority of 78% students evaluated that teachers were always fair in evaluation.




71% of the respondents performance in assignments are usually evaluated.




Only 9% of the students reported that they had opportunities for field work and excursion pointing to the need to arrange for more of the aforementioned excursion.




62% of the students were optimally satisfied with the role of teachers as gurdians.




71 percent of students opined that the college offers scope to learn and develop.




66% of the respondents felt that students usually discuss about future scope and opportunities. So this aspect requires atty and more information dissemination on career management is necessary.




Only 22% of students were satisfied with their mentors indicating that a more robust system of mentoring is necessary.




66% respondents were satisfied that examples were provided by their teachers.




63% students maintained that teachers provide mental stimulation but that 19% occasionally did so revealed that this aspect requires relooking.




66% of students said that teachers discuss about weaknesses and remedies revealing that teachers take care to map students academic progression.




66% said that teachers discuss scope of academic development which is a good academic indicator but more needs to be done.




A more 24% of teachers use innovative teaching showing that there is an immediate need to adopt the same.




Only 31% of teachers encourage extracurricular and curricular activities revealing that more emphasis needs to be placed in these associated areas.
