INTRODUCTION AND ORGANIZATION

The NSS unit of Bamanpukur Humayun Kabir Mahavidyalaya organised extension programme on “Ageing and elderly care”. The requisite permission was sought from the principal of the college for the same, and the allotment of time and date was confirmed. Notice and programme brochure were circulated to the students and the teachers accordingly.

THE PROGRAMME

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a central sector scheme of the government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It allows the students of 11th & 12th, Technical Institutions, graduate & post-graduate at colleges and university level of India to be a part of various government-led community service activities and programs. It aims to provide hands-on experience to young students in delivering community service. The growth of students' enrolment in NSS activities has been increasing from 40000 during 1969 to over 3.8 million by the end March 2018. The Mahavidyalaya celebrated extension programme on “Ageing and elderly care” at Christian Para, NSS volunteers along with the teachers and staffs of all departments of took part in the event. A total of about 45 students and faculty members participated in this event. The event started around 12 noon in seminar hall - 1 NSS Programme officer Sumita chatterjee welcomed the audience. 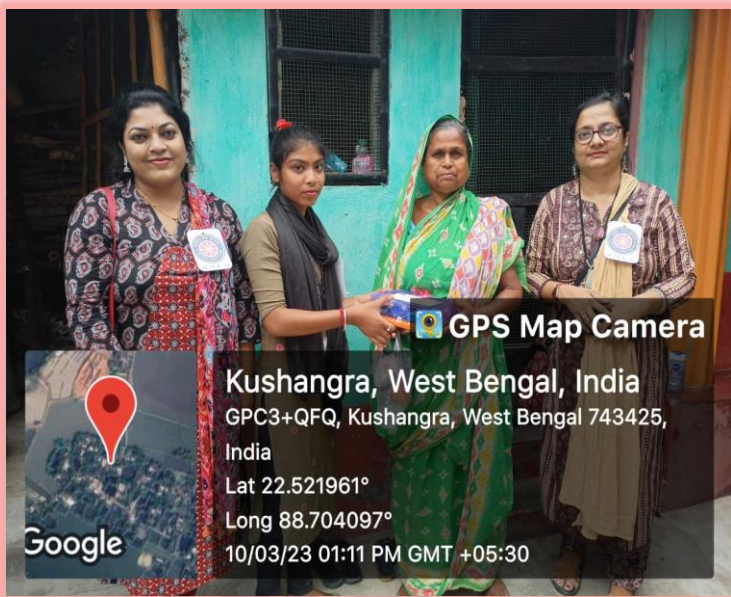
